THE ROLE OF INTERDEPARTMENTAL INTERACTION IN THE SYSTEM OF SUPPORT FOR ORPHANS AND CHILDREN LEFT WITHOUT PARENTAL CARE, AND PERSONS FROM THEIR NUMBER IN ORDER TO SUCCESSFULLY ADAPT THEM TO SOCIETY

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Summary. Postinternational support in a broad sense as a set of measures implemented on the basis of interdepartmental interaction of participants of support and aimed at successful social adaptation of graduates of institutions for orphans, their self-realization, reducing the number of offenses and crimes committed by individuals of this category, and in relation to them.

Keywords: postinternational support; child-orphans; interdepartmental cooperation.

The need to accompany orphans and children left without parental care, and persons from their number, after the termination of all forms of care for them is an urgent activity in the system of support for orphans.

One of the objectives of the "National strategy for children for 2012–2017" to ensure equal opportunities for children in need of state support is to "Create a system of post-international support for graduates" for their socialization in society.

Support of graduates is essentially an accompaniment of their social adaptation after the end of their stay in the organization for orphans and children left without parental care [1].

In a number of regions of the Russian Federation, post-internship support for graduates of all forms of care is being implemented, and the Belgorod region is no exception. Thus, in order to implement the resolution Of the government of the Belgorod region dated February 25, 2013 "on approval of the action plan" changes In social sectors aimed at improving the efficiency of education and science of the Belgorod region" from November 2014 to May 2018, the project "Creating a regional system of support for graduates of the Belgorod region "Together to success", developed by the Department of health and social protection of the population of the region, together with the Charity Fund for social assistance to children " Spread your Wings!".

The goal of the project is to create a regional system of support for graduates of all forms of care, to ensure their successful adaptation to independent life.

As part of the project, on 06.02.2015, the state University "center for training and post-international support of graduates "Spread your wings" was created. This is a unique innovative institution, the functioning of which allowed creating a regional system of support for graduates of all forms of care on the territory of the Belgorod region [2, p. 21].

The need for individual support of graduates is not in doubt.

The goal of support specialists is to solve the problems of social adaptation of graduates in the most effective way. For this purpose, a whole set of measures has been developed aimed at identifying and eliminating the causes and conditions that contribute to the social maladjustment of graduates.

Assist graduates in providing various types of assistance is based on interagency cooperation, which is a set of forms, means, methods, measures for collaboration of institutions of various departments, aimed at assisting graduates in the period of social adaptation, prevention of offenses and crimes, the organization of life and leisure, the realization of the rights and responsibilities of graduates.

Interdepartmental interaction is carried out on the basis of agreements on interdepartmental interaction, taking into account the requirements of the legislation of the Russian Federation.

Specialists, using the principle of an integrated approach, assist graduates:

- in obtaining medical services;
- in the design of social benefits (pension for loss of breadwinner, unemployment benefit, allowance for child birth);
- in registration or re-registration of documents (new passport, proof of citizenship, certificate from the housing Department, recovery of lost documents);
- in solving issues related to the implementation of rights and obligations (receiving alimony, establishing paternity, inheritance registration);
- in job search and employment (information about the situation on the labor market, assistance in finding a job, admission to additional training courses, seminars in the employment center);
- in obtaining permanent housing;
- in the write-off of outstanding utility bills;
- providing temporary housing;
- in receipt of financial assistance;
- in entering an educational institution (informing about educational institutions, assistance in choosing an educational institution, assistance in collecting documents required for admission, assistance in improving the level of knowledge);
- overcoming difficulties in training (monitoring progress and attendance, assistance in switching to an individual training schedule and meeting the requirements of the curriculum, assistance in organizing practical training);
- in receiving psychological assistance (correction of the psychological state, informing about the institutions that provide psychological services (their location and work schedule).

Thus, thanks to the clear and coordinated work of all support subjects, many problems can be solved in a short time.

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
